County Manager Michael Pomirko stated this was an update from the previous meeting along with more area to consider when making purchase order policies. County Manger Pomirko asked the board to review and we will add this area to the May regular meeting agenda. All commissioners agreed to table the purchase policy for the county until the May the meeting.


