Memorandum of Understanding (Silicon Ranch)-

County Manager Michael Pomirko explains that Silicon Ranch is our 2<sup>nd</sup> solar projects and will be bringing in \$124,000 a year with an additional \$106,000 going to the school per year. This project will take up 871 acres and change the land value to commercial. Pushing development in the county is the easiest way to bring in new revenue. County Manager Michael Pomirko then says that this company is very community oriented and will be giving a scholarship out once a year as well. Tax Assessor Heather Hardin says the school had a meeting yesterday evening and is unsure if it passed from the Board of Education but this is an amazing way to bring in new revenue. Ms. Hardin says that our dirt is our greatest resource, and we should be using it to our advantage. Commissioner Clay Reid made a motion and was seconded by Commissioner Alfonza Hall. It was unanimous.
